1. Abstract

A 54 year old women presented to our dermatology department with a history of small papule which had been present for several years.

Physical examination showed a small, translucent, soft, cystic papule measuring $3 \text{mm} \times 3 \text{ mm}$ on the left upper eyelid (Figure 1). There was no similar lesions on his body and no ophthalmological involvement.

Based on clinical finding, the diagnosis of solitary eccrine hidrocystoma was given. Surgical excision was made with no recidive after 6 months of follow up.
